

FOR THE PROCESSING OF DIGITAL PRINTING JOBS

1. Printing width

The print width can be found in the respective article-sheet. For special requests (borderless, centered, etc.), please contact your sales person before.

2. Filetype, colormode & transparency

We only accept files in RGB and LAB color space (in CMYK mode color deviations cannot be claimed) and in the formats JPG, PDF, TIF. For the most reliable color results, create files in LAB color space, such as as TIF.

To avoid problems, the files should consist only one layer and contain no embedded elements (as fonts, masks, channels, etc.).

Files containing transparencies can cause problems - and should therefore be avoided.

3. Dimensions & resolution

Please create the data in original size (scale 1: 1). The resolution of the data should be 150 to 300 dpi. Especially when creating very large files (with page lengths larger than 1m) a resolution of 300dpi should not be exceeded!

3. File limitations

The maximum file size, so that we can postprocess the file in Photoshop (if agreed upon) is 4GB for a TIFF.

In case of deviation from these details, a complaint-free production cannot be guaranteed!
